Equestrian Safety Training- Fall/Winter

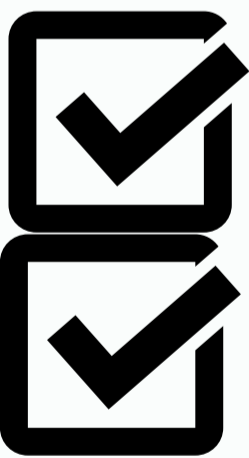

ATTEND 3 GUIDED OUTINGS

New docents are required to attend at least 3 guided outings. This can include docent only outings. Returning docents must attend at least 3 outings in a support capacity to remain active.

ENDORSED BY 2 LEAD DOCENTS

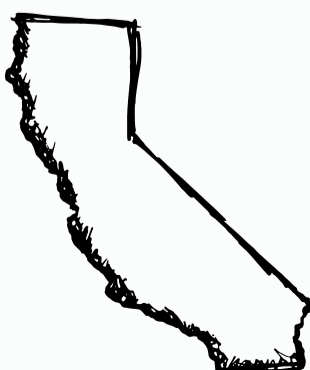
To become a new lead docent, you must be recommended by 2 Lead Docents and approved by SVC staff. Familiarity to Deer Creek Hills and a working cell phone are also required.

VALID CPR/FIRST AID/AED CERTIFICATION

Valid First Aid/CPR/AED certification is required and must be maintained.
